| T201X | I can't seem to get the <br> external alert to work with <br> version 2.64 PGM. | T2000 Windows Conventional Programming Software V2.64.0. <br> It has been found that when the AUX key is set to "External" using the Windows programming <br> software, that it does not enable the External Alert feature of the radio. <br> The correct operation of AUX key when configured to "External" is that the AUX LED should <br> latch on when the auxiliary key is pressed, to indicate that External Alert mode is active. <br> The T2000 Windows programming software, does not program the radio correctly. <br> It sets the AUX key to "Momentary" instead of "External". <br> Tait recommend that if you require control of the External Alert, via the AUX key, that you use <br> the DOS T201X programming software V1.40, which does not have this problem. |
| T5015 | Whenever I try to program <br> the radio, the software goes <br> back to the KEY SETTINGS <br> page. | This is caused by the software trying to guide the user back to an error on a page. However a <br> help message should pop-up describing the fault. This will be fixed in the next release of <br> programming software. <br> The problem is caused by 'Scan after PTT' option being un-ticked. <br> To get around this you need to either tick this option, or assign a function key to 'Flexiscan <br> Toggle'. |
