# Missing Test Point on T201X Logic 220-01377-07

### **Applicability**

This Technical Note applies to all T201X's that use the logic board with the IPN of 220-01377-07

### **Information**

In the M2000-00 Series II Service Manual Section 8.14, Test Point (TP) 609 is referred to in the set-up instructions for the T2000-A80. This information shows that for a T201x, a line needs to be run from the S24 connector of the -A80 board to TP609 on the logic board of the T201x.

For versions of the 220-01377-0x logic before version -06 this is a true and accurate instruction. However with the release of the -07 board, TP609 was accidentally removed. With the release of the 220-01377-08 board the Test Point was re-instated.

When adding a T2000-A80 to a T201X with an "-07" logic board the suggested work around is to solder the lead from the T2000-A80 onto S20 pin 4.
