Release Of The T2000 Tait Programming Utilities V2.80

10th March 2005

Applicability

This Technical Note applies to all standard conventional and trunking T2000 radios

1. Introduction

Information

The last full release of the T2000 Tait Programming Utilities (TPU) was V2.71 (TN-875-SR) that installed V2.71 of both the T2000 Conventional Programming Application (CPA) and Trunked Programming Application (TPA). V2.71 has now been updated to the T2000 TPU V2.80. **This version will install V2.80 of the TPA and V2.82 of the CPA**.

2. Changes

What Has Changed?

The main changes to the programming Software are as follows: -

CPA

- Problems with disabling the birdie killer (refer TIMS28948 /FOCUS16274)
- Auxiliary key set to External not working (refer TIMS28852 /FOCUS16247)
- Tone Blanking default has been changed to Disabled (refer TIMS31357/FOCUS17234)
- Incorrect Frequencies allowed for 800MHz in CPA (refer TIMS31388/FOCUS17257)
- Folder name when installing into non-default location (refer TIMS29750/FOCUS16533)
- Warning needed when reading in old DOS file (TIMS38981)

- Birdie Killer not working in a T2030/35 (refer TIMS34970 /FOCUS18015)
- Nokia system, Group Numbers Changing (refer TIMS37249 /FOCUS18361)
- External Alert "Active Time" extended to 250 seconds or continuous (refer TIMS32450/FOCUS17511)
- Incorrect Frequencies in allowed for 800 MHz in TPA (refer TIMS31392 /FOCUS17257)
- 6.25kHz Offset allowed for the "-826" radios (refer TIMS33356 /FOCUS17615)
- Deleting a Network requires a warning (refer TIMS29680 /FOCUS16525)
- Two new check-box fields required for External Alert (refer TIMS29945)
- Variation to External Alert operation on T2035 Trunked radio (refer TIMS29071)
- Errors occurring when using a DOS .dat file in windows TPA (refer TIMS38720)
